The Appian Impact Fund (the Fund) is a multi-asset fund which follows a similar investment strategy to the Appian Multi Asset Fund. It differentiates itself by having an ethical and impact focus. It is a diversified fund that invests in a comprehensive range of traditional and alternative asset classes which includes equities, fixed income, property, infrastructure, venture capital, commodities, forestry and currencies.

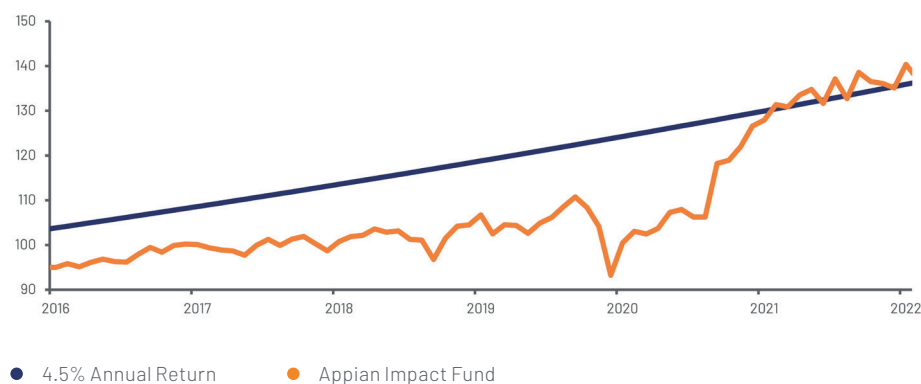
The Fund is characterised by a dynamic strategic asset allocation process that ensures the reduction of risk and variations in value. The Fund further reduces its risk profile and increases levels of diversification by investing across a variety of geographic areas and sectors.

Fund objective

The Fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing on a diversified basis in transferable securities, such as equity securities and debt securities, and collective investment schemes (including exposure to alternatives such as property and forestry). The Fund's investments will be subject to an ethical screening process.

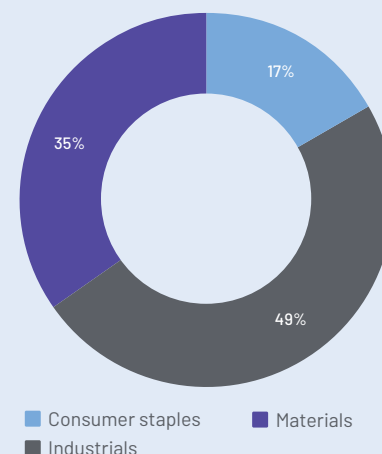

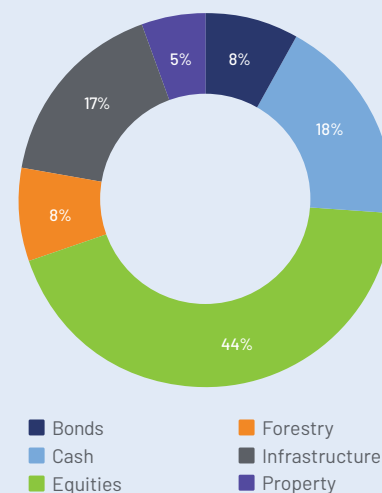
